

Call for Video & Interactive Works

An immersive video dome is being planned for the 2015 Nashville Mini Maker Faire on September 12, 2015. The dome is 20 feet in diameter, standing 4 feet above ground with a full-dome two-projector setup inside.

- Video, animation and sound artists are encouraged to submit works
- Works can be abstract, narrative, realistic, interactive or experimental
- Works must be suitable for audiences of all ages
- Interactive artists will need to discuss specifics of equipment and software with Jennifer (ittybittyartist@gmail.com)

Aug. 16 - Dome Distortion Hands-on Work Session

- How do you turn your video or animated footage into something that will play in a dome?
- We will be using After Effects to render footage
- (Suggested donation \$20 - any donations will be put toward dome materials.)
- Bring your own computer and footage to participate

Aug. 28 - Submissions Due

- For final consideration send a Dropbox, Vimeo, YouTube or other link to ittybittyartist@gmail.com
- Videos should be 1920x1080 or 1280x720
- Please send a still image to be used for promotional materials. 1920x1080 pixels or larger.
- Complete and email the attached submission form to ittybittyartist@gmail.com
- Two videos (front and back of dome) should be submitted both for consideration and as final footage

Aug. 30 - Notification of acceptance sent to artists

- Artists will be notified by email
- Rerendering by the artist may be necessary prior to show, once video is tested in dome system

Aug. 31 - Sept. 5 - Preview

- Artist availability for dome preview is requested
- Individual appointments will be set up during evenings and weekend hours

Sept. 6 - Final renders must be received

Sept. 12 - Installation at Mini Maker Faire

- Please volunteer for a shift at the dome if you are able!
- Plan on being available to spend time at the dome and talking with the public!

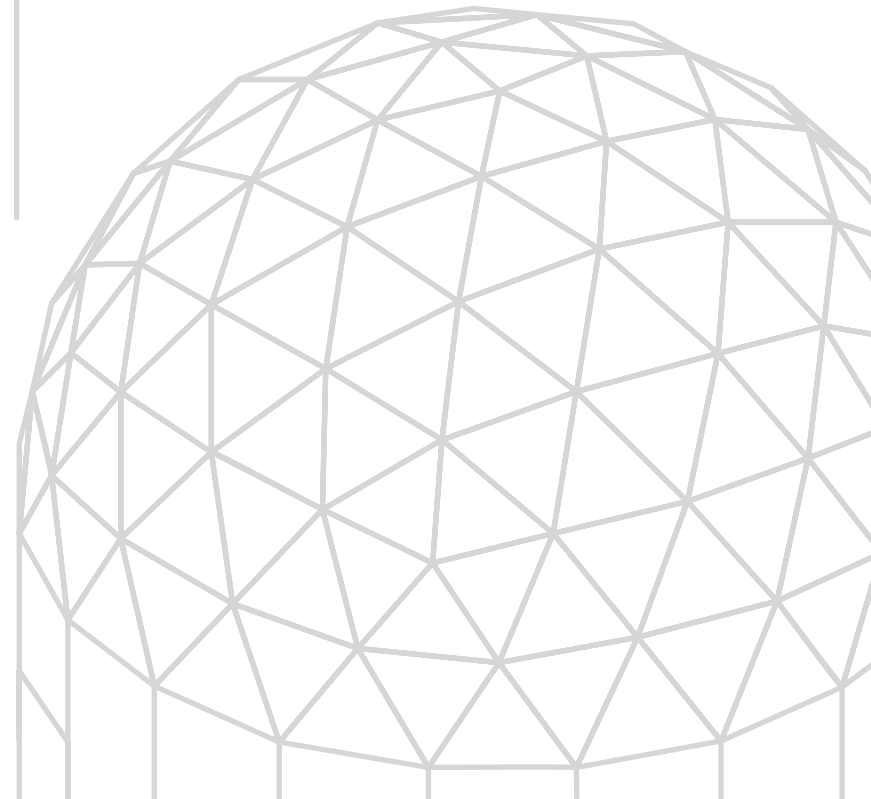
